## PHYSICAL TOUCH

"Cuddle me! Chase me!"

For the ones who are touchy-feely, you can express their love language through physical touch. They need that physical proximity.



## QUALITY TIME

"Come here! Look at this!"

For the ones who like to be with you, their love language is quality time. Their love tanks are filled by the moments they share with you.



## ACTS OF SERVICE

"You do it for me!"  
or "Let's do it together"

For the ones who like to do things with you, their love language is acts of service. They find helping others to be fulfilling.



## GIFTS

"Presents, please!"

For the ones who like tangible things, their love language is gifts. The thought behind the gifts is what drives them.



## WORDS OF AFFIRMATION

"Talk to me!"

For the ones who like to speak and read, their love language is words of affirmation. They feed off spoken or written encouragement and appreciation.
